

#### URBANIZATION

According to a United Nations report date 10 July 2014<sup>7</sup>, 54% of the world's population lived in urban areas, and it was expected to increase to 66% by 2050. Projections show that urbanization combined with the overall growth of the world's population could add another 2.5 billion people to urban populations by 2050. In 1990, there were ten megacities each with 10 million inhabitants or more, the number of which increased to 28 megacities worldwide in 2014, out of these megacities, sixteen are located in Asia, four in Latin America, three each in Africa and Europe, and two in Northern America. Nearly half of the world's 3.9 billion urban dwellers reside in relatively small settlements with fewer than 500,000 inhabitants, while only around one in eight live in the 28 megacities with 10 million inhabitants or more. Many of the fastest growing cities in the world are relatively small urban settlements. Tokyo remains the world's largest city with 38 million inhabitants; followed by Delhi with 25 million; Shanghai with 23 million; Mexico City, Mumbai and São Paulo, each with around 21 million; Osaka with over 20 million; Beijing with about 20 million; and the New York-Newark area and Cairo with around 18.5 million inhabitants each. UN press release of revised statistics on 16 May 2018<sup>8</sup> stated that of total the world population, 55% lived in urban areas in 2018 which is projected to increase to 68% by 2050, and by 2030, the world is projected to have 43 megacities with more than 10 million inhabitants.

As the world continues to urbanize, sustainable development depends increasingly on the successful management of urban growth, as many countries will need integrated policies to improve the lives of both urban and rural dwellers, facing challenges in meeting the needs of the growing urban populations for housing, transportation, energy systems and other infrastructure, for employment and basic services such as education and health care, and to ensure that the benefits of urbanization are fully shared and inclusive with access to infrastructure and social services for all in a safe environment.

Human-Centric Design (HCD)<sup>9</sup> is a design that provides services by understanding the needs and motivations of people and their behaviors. HCD is based on Apple's Genius Bar which in turn is based on the comprehensive service provided by Ritz-Carlton.

Created under the Barak Hussain Obama administration, yet to be revoked by the current Donald Trump administration, the US Digital Service (USDS) and 18F are responsible for making government services accessible to the people in need thereof through efficient use of the HCD technology. An example of a successful HCD is the 18 pages, 3,904 words, and 213 questions Paper Services Application (PSA) of Michigan's Department of Health and Human Services, developed in collaboration with the Detroit-based design studio Civilla by reducing the size of the original PSA comprising 40 pages, 18,000 words, and 1,000 questions. A number of cities like San Francisco have iTeams to solve ongoing municipal problems using HCD. In the past five years, a Hyper-Converged Infrastructure (HCI) has established itself as an ideal technology for organizations delivering new and complex services rapidly, working with limited resources, managing data centers, moving to the cloud, and preparing for the future using technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), the Internet of Things (IOT)<sup>10</sup>, Digital Twins (DTs)<sup>11</sup>, and Blockchain<sup>12</sup> have great promise in the public sector. The Chicago Citykey<sup>13</sup> with HCD is the new government-issued identification card to access municipal services online transitioning from the institution centric design to the HCD, a new normal where services are tailored to the needs of the citizens.

## **MORTALITY**

In the past century, the mortality of human beings has fallen with an increase in longevity and healthcare costs. However, the longevity of a segment of people recognized by the SCOTUS has reversed, and today, corporations have a one in three chances of dying within the first five years, due to infant mortality, congenital disorders, or infectious diseases, such as bankruptcy, liquidation, M&A, recession, depression, or other causes of corporate demise, about six times the death rate of companies 40 years ago. They now are dying at a younger age than their employees, irrespective of size, age, or sector. Neither scale too big to die nor experience of age guards against the sudden death syndrome and an early demise of companies.

Sustainability is the capacity to create, test, and maintain adaptive capability. Development is the process of creating, testing, and maintaining opportunity. The phrase that combines the two, sustainable development, refers to the goal of fostering adaptive capabilities and creating opportunities.

Hierarchies and adaptive cycles comprise the basis of ecosystems and social-ecological systems across scales. Together they form a panarchy - a form of governance that encompasses all. The panarchy describes how a healthy system can invent and experiment, benefiting from inventions that create opportunity while being kept safe from those that destabilize because of their nature or excessive exuberance<sup>14</sup>.




Both natural and engineered systems are fundamentally dynamical in nature: their defining properties are causal, and their organizational and functional capacities are

causally grounded. Among dynamical systems, an interesting and important sub-class are those that are autonomous, anticipative and adaptive.

Living systems, intelligent systems, sophisticated robots and social systems belong to this class Complex systems from tropical forests to stock

markets to companies survive in a Darwinian survival of the fittest, the fittest being the system that adapts to the changes in its environment and adjusts to the environment<sup>15</sup>.

A successful system continually evolves through a cycle of 1) interactions, 2) emergence, and 3) feedback in unpredictable ways and is called complex adaptive system (CAS).

Each CAS is nested in a broader system, e.g., an individual organism nested in a population of its species is a CAS nested in its natural ecosystem<sup>16</sup>, which itself is nested in the broader biological environment, which in turn is nested in the biosphere, and so on. Similarly, a company is a CAS nested in a business ecosystem, which is nested in the broad societal environment, which in turn is nested in the global economy having complexity at multiple levels, including the diversity within the company at different levels , with the inevitable individualistic tension between any two individuals, levels, and an individual agent and the larger system.

The study of CASs, from cells to societies, is a study of the interplay among processes operating at diverse scales of space, time and organizational complexity. The key to success is an understanding of the interrelationships between microscopic processes and macroscopic patterns, and the evolutionary forces that shape systems. For ecosystems and socioeconomic systems focused on broad scale features such as diversity and resiliency, evolution operates most powerfully at the level of individual agents. Understanding how cooperation, coalitions and networks of interaction emerge from individual behaviors and feed back to influence those behaviors is required for the success<sup>17</sup>.

Considering the increasing pace of technological change and volatility in many industries, the patterns suggest that the need for transformation is rising, while the chance of successfully achieving it is falling. An optimal application of structural principles that deal with the design of the system seen in nature and managerial

principles that deal with the application of the intelligence intentionality provided by humans, together, may help make CAS robust successfully achieving the required transformation, of course, involving a cost for each principle. Accordingly, treating an organization as CAS, giving more importance to the interactions within a CAS than the discrete actions of the individual parts, looking at the system as a whole across the parts and relationships among parts rather than the individual parts, and managing with minimum specifications having flexibility and opportunity to innovate that would yield more creativity than micromanaged detailed plans, allows the organization to live longer, healthier, and more productive life<sup>18</sup>.
