Venkatakavi was a contemporary and the court poet of king Raghunadha, who was also a well-known poet (<http://www.vepachedu.org/manasanskriti/Raghunadha.pdf>).

Venkatakavi was known for his figurative poetry. His speciality was pun/double entendre (*slesha*) and humor (*chamatkaaramu*). He was an expert in using proverbs, adages, maxims, sayings etc.
